How long will it take to be accepted?

Once your application is 100% complete and submitted, our team will begin processing your application. This process typically takes 2-3 weeks.

Do you require an official transcript?

Yes, to be accepted into Churchome College we require that an official transcript be sent to our office from the most recent school you attended. Please request that the official transcript be sent to:

Where will I live?

Students can apply to live in student housing which is located 1.8 miles (5 minutes) from our Churchome Kirkland location where classes take place. These apartments are shared living spaces with about 4-6 other students. Each apartment is fully furnished, located in a prime area, includes a workout facility, pool, and sauna. Housing is available on a limited basis, with first priority going to out of state students. What does my maintenance fee for housing pay for?

A one time maintenance fee of \$250 is collected prior to move-in. This maintenance fee/security deposit is refundable up to \$200.

Do I have to live in student housing?

No, students are allowed to live wherever they desire. Student housing is simply provided as an option and is based on a priority basis.

What kind of transportation is available?

Everything you need to know about buses in [King County](#). Current schedules, maps, news, and more. Additionally, many students carpool to and from classes. Weather permitting, bicycling and walking are also great options.

How much is tuition?

2018-2019 tuition for the academic school year (Fall & Spring semesters) is \$7,000.

What is the tuition deposit?

The current deposit for tuition is \$3,000 for the academic year. If you start as a new student in the Spring, the deposit for the semester is \$1,500.

Do you offer financial aid?

We do not participate in Federal or State aid (FAFSA) but we do offer a limited amount in scholarship aid.

Am I eligible for scholarships?

Churchome offers a limited amount of scholarships to students after completion of their first year.

What are the payment plan options?

There are two payment options:

- i. Tuition can be paid in one lump sum.
- ii. After deposit (\$3000) is received, students can set-up a monthly payment plan of eight equal payments of \$500/month.

Can I work to pay for my education?

Absolutely! Students are able to work around their class schedules. Our weekly schedule is Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8AM-3PM. We ask that students prioritize their Churchome College experience and work around this schedule.

What is the difference between the program in Seattle and the program in LA?

Great question! LA is an abbreviated experience, to give students a taste of what is offered in Seattle. Seattle is a full time program consisting of two academic semesters per year for up to three years resulting in an Associate degree in Church Ministry and a year of internship. Only the Seattle site offers student housing through the college and accepts international students.

Can credits be transferred to other colleges?

Some colleges will accept Churchome College credits. You will need to work with the Registrar's office or Transfer representative of the school you are interested in transferring to.

Do you accept transfer credits to Churchome College?

Our classes and degree is very specific, so unfortunately we do not accept any transfer credits from other colleges.

What degree do you offer?

Churchome College offers an Associate in Church Ministry.

How much homework will there be?

Students should anticipate an average of 2 hours of coursework outside of the classroom for every hour they spend in class.

When are my classes?

Classes will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8AM-3PM.

How do I register for classes?

Once you are accepted into Churchome College, check your email for your login and password and then follow the links to login to Populi, our academic database. This is where you will be billed for tuition as well as access all courses for assignment and paper submissions, as well as exam and project grades. Once you are logged in please do the following to enroll in classes:

- Select Academic Term (ex: Spring 2019) under the Register For tabs
- Click the green Enroll button for classes

How long will it take to get a degree?

Churchome College is a two year program. Students receive their degree after successfully completing the full two year program.
